



SSAY IT stands for Same Sex Attracted Youth including Intersex and Transgender. SSAY IT is a confidential, safe and supportive space in which young people can explore their diverse genders and sexualities.

SSAY IT meets once a week for group activities which can range from sexual health or creative arts workshops through to social outings like grabbing coffee or going to the movies

You can come by yourself or with a friend. We welcome anyone interested in participating in an inclusive and discrimination free society.

Coming Out

Talking about your sexuality is a lifelong journey for everyone. Talking about it for the first time to family members, friends and other people can sometimes be a celebratory experience and other times can be stressful. There are right and wrong ways about 'coming out' and if you would like to talk to someone about how you might approach it we can help.

Remember you never have to disclose your sexuality to anyone if you don't want

Social Support

Meet other young people like yourself. Share your likes, dislikes, experiences and issues. Make friends and expand your social network.

Sexual Health

Sexually diverse people do it differently. So if you're confused or curious this might be the place to ask. We offer information and referral about all things related to your sexual health including info on sexual health checks, STIs, sexually diverse safe sex practices and safe sex packs.

Advocacy

If you feel you are being treated unfairly or want to be represented by someone, come talk to us about your problem or the action you might want to take.

Counselling

Unfortunately many young people are subject to negative experiences because of their sexuality such as family upset, bullying or discrimination. If you would like to talk to someone about your experience in a confidential setting, please don't hesitate to ask one of the workers if you can talk to someone.
